Dear Berthholder,

Work on the long awaited toilet/shower block at the Harbour is now near completion and the facilities should be in commission within the next five weeks. Unfortunately, this is somewhat later than had been anticipated and work will now have to commence on the refurbishment of the old toilet and shower block on Monday 26th November 2018, in order for this to be completed on time. This will unfortunately cause some disruption over the next five weeks.

We would like to make you aware therefore of the following measures we have taken:

- Temporary toilets and showers will be brought in for the five week period
- The laundry facilities will unfortunately have to close during the five week period
- Electric cards will only be available at the office
- Wifi connection will be disrupted, but we will endeavour to keep this to a minimum
- There will only be one entrance for cars, the Jakes Quay area will have to be blocked off and parking at the Harbour will be at a premium, we would ask that you bear this in mind if or when visiting. Unfortunately, this will be in place until April 2019.

During the time that the above works are being undertaken, the contractors on site will endeavour to ensure that everything is carried out to make the process as neighbour friendly as they can.

Thank you all very much for your support and patience and we look forward to the new shower/toilet/laundry block opening very soon.
